

The RTYC 2010 Club Racing Programme

Welcome to the RTYC Club Racing Programme, all the relevant documents can be found on the Club Web Site, including Notice of Race, Entry Forms and Sailing Instructions. Club Racing commences on Saturday 03rd April for Juniors and PY Dinghies and Sunday 04th April for the main Fleets. The majority of racing will be conducted from our Committee Boat with a fall back to our temporary Starting Platform at the base of Haldon Pier when required.

Club Racing is open to Members of Royal Torbay Yacht Club. Visitors may enter Club Racing at the discretion of the Sailing Committee.

Juniors. The Cadets and RS Feva's will race together on a Saturday afternoon and Wednesday evenings.

PY Dinghy. Open to all PY Dinghies including Flying Fifteens. The PY Dinghies will race on Saturday afternoons and Wednesday evenings.

Folkboat. Open to the British Nordic Folkboat.

Sports Boats. Open to all Sports Boats including Laser SB3's.

Torbay Progressive Handicap. Open to Yachts that do not hold an IRC Certificate, if you opt to White Sail the handicap will be adjusted accordingly allowing minimum crewed yachts to race.

IRC. Open to yachts holding a valid IRC Certificate.

This season we are trying to keep competitors better informed, if the Race Officer decides to cancel racing. The mobile phone number that you enter on your Entry Form will be loaded into the RO's phone and a group text message will be sent by the RO if he decides to cancel racing. This phone will live in the Sailing Office and will be available to all our Race Officers.
