NOTICE OF RACE

ALL TIMES ARE BRITISH SUMMER TIME (BST)

1. RULES

- 1.1 The championship will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 The Prescriptions of the Royal Yachting Association will apply.
- 1.3 Rules of the National Hornet Class will apply (except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions).
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2. **ADVERTISING**

Advertising will be classified as Category 'C'.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The championship is open to all boats of the National Hornet Class.
- 3.2 Helmspersons and crews must be either fully paid-up adult or junior members of the National Hornet Class.
- 3.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee, to The Club Secretary, Royal Torbay Yacht Club, 12 Beacon Terrace, Torquay TQ1 2BH by Friday 15 July 2007.
- 3.4 Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Race Committee who may impose a £25 additional entry fee.

4. **FEES**

4.1 The required entry fees are as follows:

Full Members $- \pounds 130$ Junior Members $- \pounds 90$ (Helm must be under 21 years on 01/01/07)Overseas Entrants $\pounds 110$

4.2 The entry fee may be paid by instalments as indicated below:

4.3 All entries received by 15 March 2007 will be entered into a free draw for a McNamara Genoa.

5. SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Registration: Saturday 28 July from 1400 hours to 1800 hours.
- 5.2 Measurement and inspection: Saturday 28 July from 1400 hours to 1800 hours.
- 5.3 Dates of racing and number of races:
 Sunday 29 July Race 1 and Race 2
 Monday 30 July Race 3
 Tuesday 31 July Race 4 and Race 5
 Wednesday 1 August Race 6 and Crews Race
 Thursday 2 August Race 7 and Race 8
 Friday 3 August Race 9 and Race 10
- 5.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 1055 hours.

6. **MEASUREMENTS**

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available after 1400 hours on Saturday 28 July at the Race Office.

8. THE COURSES

Trapezoid or Windward-Leeward-Triangle courses will be laid in Torbay.

9. SCORING

- 9.1 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 9.2 (a) When fewer than four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
 - (b) When from four to seven races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
 - (c) When eight or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

10. **PRIZES**

Prizes will be given as follows:
