1. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located at Royal Torbay Yacht Club, 12 Beacon Terrace, Torquay.

2. SIGNAL MADE ASHORE

Signals made ashore will be displayed from the Royal Torquay Yacht Club flag pole at the inshore end of Haldon Pier.

3. SCHEDULE OF RACES

4. RACING AREA

The racing will be in Torbay.

5. THE COURSES

5.1 The diagrams in Appendix A show the courses, the order in which marks are to be passed and the side on which each mark is to be left.

5.2 No later than the Warning Signal, the Race Committee Signal Boat will display the course and the number of rounds to be sailed on a blackboard.

5.3 No later than the Warning Signal, the Race Committee Signal Boat will display the approximate compass bearing of the first leg.

6. MARKS

6.1 Marks 1, 2a, 2b and the Spreader Mark will be yellow inflatable buoys.

6.2 The Starting Mark will be a white dan buoy displaying an orange flag at the port end of the starting line.

6.3 The Finishing Mark will be a white dan buoy displaying a blue flag at the port end of the finishing line.

7. PRIZES

Prizes will be given to the first three boats in each category i.e. Gold, Silver, Bronze.

8. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

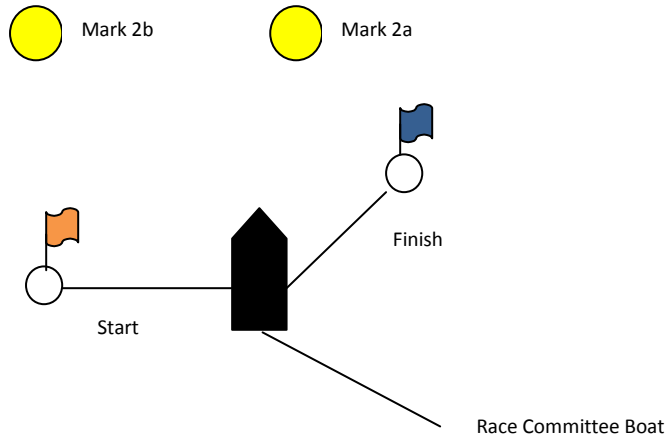

Round 1 Start, Mark 1 to port, Gate (Mark 2a to port, Mark 2b to starboard)

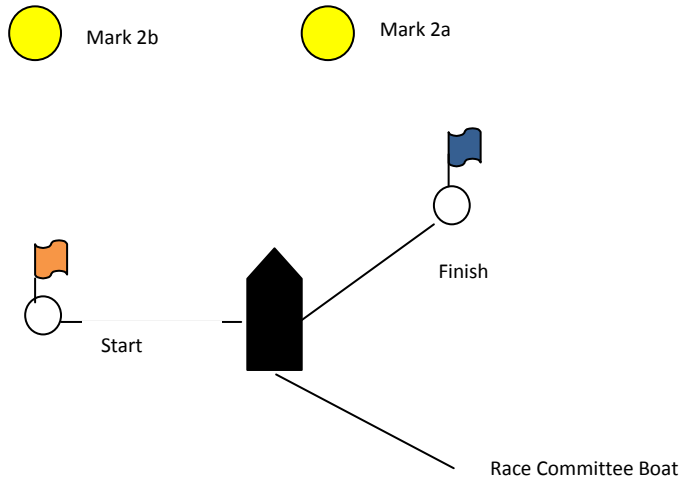
Round 2 and all subsequent rounds Mark 1 to port, Gate (Mark 2a to port, Mark 2b to starboard)
