## 1. **THE WEEKEND**

- 1.1 The Coached Weekend will be run by two Feva Class Coaches assisted by RTYC Club Coaches.
- 1.2 The weekend will be fully coached with the aim of improving various aspects of RS Feva sailing.

## 2. **IMAGE RIGHTS**

Competitors automatically grant to the organising authority, without payment, the right in perpetuity to make, use and show any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television of or relating to the event.

## 3. **ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1 The Coached Weekend is open to all boats of the RS Feva Class.
- 3.2 Eligible boats of the RS Feva Class may enter for the Coached Weekend by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee, to The Club Secretary, Royal Torbay Yacht Club, 12 Beacon Terrace, Torquay TQ1 2BH.
- 3.3 Competitors under the age of 18 years at the time of the event shall be required to complete and lodge the parental/guardian consent form included on the entry form at time of registration.

## 4. **FEES**

- 4.1 The entry fee will be £40.00 per boat.
- 4.2 The entry fee includes launching and berthing.
- 4.3 The Weekend will be fully coached and may include coached racing. Informal results may be produced for the racing. All on-water activities will be fully briefed before going afloat.
- 4.4 The fee includes a Sailing Supper for the two crew, served in RTYC Saturday evening. Value £5 each, no cash alternative will be available.

## 5. **SCHEDULE**

- 5.1 Registration:  
Saturday 6th June from 0800 to 1000 hours in the RTYC Clubhouse.
- 5.2 Dates of times of Coaching:  
Saturday 6th June 1000 to 1700  
Sunday 7th June 0930 to 1500

## 6. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 6.1 There will be no Sailing Instructions for this Coached Weekend.

## 7. **BERTHING**

- 7.1 Boat parking will be on Haldon Pier with launching down the adjacent slipway into Torquay Harbour.
- 7.2 All cars need to be removed from the boat storage, launching area to the Car Park as soon as possible.

## 8. **SAILING WATERS**

- 8.1 The on-water coaching will take place outside of Torquay Harbour in the waters of Torbay.

## 9. **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

- 9.1 Competitors participate in the Coached Weekend entirely at their own risk. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the Coached Weekend.
- 9.2 Competitors are entirely responsible for their own safety, whether afloat or ashore, and nothing in any other documents or anywhere else reduces this responsibility.
- 9.3 It is for the competitors to decide whether their boat is fit to sail in the conditions in which it will find itself. By launching or going to sea, the competitors confirm that the boat is fit for those conditions and they are competent to sail and compete in them.
- 9.4 Nothing done by the organisers can reduce the responsibility of the owners and/or competitors, nor will it make the organisers responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, however it may have occurred, as a result of the boat taking part in the racing. The organisers encompass everyone helping to run the race and the event, and include Royal Torbay Yacht Club, the organising authority, the race committee, the race officer, patrol boats and beach masters.
- 9.5 The provision of patrol boats does not relieve the owner/competitor of their responsibilities.

## 10. **INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2,000,000 or the equivalent.
