## **Amendment No 2 to the Sailing Instructions**

SI 8.7 replace "2100 on the second race of racing" by "0800 on the first day of the final series".

#### SI 11 Racing Area

Add 'The wave monitoring buoy and appendages located at co-ordinates 50°25' N 003°31' W is designated an obstruction by the race committee.'

SI 18 Penalty system. Delete and Replace with:

# 18 **Penalty System**

- 18.1 Rule 44.1 is changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.
- 18.2 Rule 44.1 is changed to permit a boat that has broken a rule of Part 2 or 31.1 to take a penalty after racing but prior to any protest hearing. Her penalty shall be a scoring penalty as calculated in rule 44.3(c) equal to 25% of the number of boats in the boat's assigned group rounded up to the next whole number.
- 18.3 **Appendix P** (Special Procedures for Rule 42) applies amended as follows:
  - P2.1 When a boat is penalized under rule P1 her penalty shall be a One-Turn Penalty under rule 44.2. If she fails to take it she shall be disqualified without a hearing.

P2.2 and P2.3 are deleted.

# 18.4 Penalty for an infraction of Class Rule C3.3 Positioning.

If a boat is observed by the jury infringing Class rule C3.3, she may be penalized as soon as reasonably possible. The penalty will be signalled by making a sound signal, pointing a yellow flag at her and hailing her sail number, even if the boat is no longer racing. A boat so penalized shall take a One-Turn Penalty under rule 44.2.

- 18.5 If a member of the Jury, witnesses a breach of a part 2 rule or rule 31, he may indicate by whistling and displaying a red flag, that he is able to witness if a protest is lodged about that incident.
- SI 20.2 In the last sentence change '...on the ground floor...' for '.... On the third floor...'
- SI 20.4 Delete and replace by:
  - 20.4 Breaches of instructions 2, 3, 6.2, 23.1, 26, 27 and 28 will not be grounds for protest by a boat. This changes rule 60.1 (a). Penalties for these breaches and a breach of a Class Rule may be less than disqualification if the jury so decides.
- SI 21 Arbitration. Delete and replace with:

### 21. Arbitration system

- 21.1 As an alternative to a complete protest hearing by the jury for an alleged breach of a rule of Part 2 or Rule 31, the parties may be given the choice of using the arbitration system. This is changing rules 63 and 64
- 21.2 Both the protestor and protestee have the option of accepting the arbitrator's opinion. This may result in the protest going on to full protest hearing, the protest being withdrawn and/or a party taking 25% scoring penalty (see SI 18).
