It is likely that some or all of the items listed here may be checked. Other items not listed may also be checked at the discretion of the organisers.

Competitors are reminded that it is their responsibility for ensuring that their boat complies with the class rules in ALL respects (RRS 78.1). A copy of the class rules is available from the Technical section of the International Cadet Class website <http://www.cadetclass.org/>

Sails (Maximum 2 suits)	Previously measured & with ICC label/button	
Hull Weight	Minimum 54kg	D.10.1
Mast	Limit marks (black bands)	F.3.4
Boom	Limit marks (black bands)	F.4.4
Spinnaker pole length	Maximum 1219mm	F.5.5
Daggerboard length	Maximum length 887 mm Maximum Extension 597mm	E.3.3.3 C.8.1.2
Daggerboard use	Shockcord	C.8.1.3
Rudder Use	Secured e.g. Rudder clip on wooden boats	C.8.2.4

Hulls should be dry when presented for weighing and already de-rigged of all detachable fittings including the shrouds, painter, kicker and mainsheet.

Sails should be dry when presented for inspection. Please note sails must have been previously measured, we will not be able to measure new sails at this event.
