Time limit 3 hours.

At the sole discretion of the race officer, two races may be held. The warning signal for the second race will be displayed as soon as possible after the finish of the previous race.

Time limit for second race 1.5 hours.

For August 18th Only the Saturday 17th August races will be moved to the Sunday but will not be part of the Saturday series and starts will follow the normal start sequence and for Sunday as follows
